Exhibits a relatively deep, brickish red color and offers classic Pinot character, with an aromatic mix of boysenberry, cherry and hints of spice, leather, grilled apple and smoked nuts. It has considerable weight for its tight framework with nice intensity and grip, which carries into the pleasant lingering finish.

Serve with roasts or stews, and all types of poultry – especially turkey and duck.
